Sons of Alchemy Pouring Event Tap Assignment Procedure

Background

We have two four-tap jockey boxes. Our CO2 manifolds can push up to 10 kegs at a time, i.e. the 8 jockey box taps plus 2 picnic taps. If we have more than 10 kegs to serve, the following procedure will be used.

Tap Assignment Procedure

Club membership seniority, based on the start date of a member's most recent continuous membership, will be used.

Co-brewed kegs will use the more senior member's seniority.

Each participant will be assigned a first tap before anyone is assigned a second (or third, etc.) tap.

The jockey box taps will be filled first, followed by the picnic taps. An exception to this is beers with live non-saccharomyces yeast and/or bacteria. These kegs can only be assigned to picnic taps. Members with live bug beers should bring their own picnic taps and CO2 setups.

Kegs #11, 12, etc. will be held in reserve and added as other kegs are kicked. If this is you, bring a bucket to hold your reserve keg in ice.

Exception

Participants can swap a tap assignment(s) if mutually agreed.
